INSTRUCTIONS FOR POSTER PRESENTATIONS

Poster presentation guidelines

When preparing your poster please note the following:

- Poster dimensions should not exceed 90x120 cm – width/height
- State the title and the authors at the top of your poster. Text should be easy to read and in bold letters
- Indicate the presenting author if different from the first author
- The text and the illustrations should be easy to read from a distance of 2 meters
- Please disclose any potential conflict of interest; conflicts of interest needs to be declared at the bottom of the poster

The presence of authors at their posters

Authors are asked to be at their posters during both coffee breaks (morning and afternoon) to allow delegates to visit and discuss the work.

e-Poster submission

Due to the high number of poster presentations, the EAPC has decided to make all posters available in a digital format. The electronic posters will be available to all delegates during and after the congress – thus, extending the time during which your poster is displayed.

We encourage all poster presenters to take advantage of this possibility.
